Twenty (20) scholarships at a value of \$6,000 each to be awarded to high quality students entering full-time graduate studies in the W Booth School of Engineering Practice & Technology, McMaster University. This award is available for the first year of study in one of the following programs:

- Master of Engineering Entrepreneurship and Innovation (MEEI)
- Master of Technology Entrepreneurship and Innovation (MTEI)
- Master of Engineering and Public Policy (MEPP)
- Master of Engineering Design (MED)

Eligibility

The **W Booth School Leadership Excellence Awards** are provided exclusively for students qualifying for admission to one of the programs listed for the study session beginning in **January 2017**. This award is available to students who are Canadian citizens or who have Permanent Residence status in Canada. Eligible applicants will present a B or higher academic standing in the final year of study of a pre-requisite undergraduate degree program. Students must be registered as entering full-time students in order to receive the scholarship.

Summary of Selection Criteria

The scholarship will be awarded based on:

1. Demonstrated leadership capability through extracurricular activities, community contribution and/or previous employment;
2. Two(2) letters of reference from individuals who know the applicant in the context of the activities listed in the above criteria statement; and a
3. Short essay statement detailing the applicant's leadership experience, personal goals and professional aspirations as an innovative leader. (See application form)

Award Process

All award applicants must complete and submit a scholarship application form after the School of Graduate Studies online application process has been **completed**. Applications will be reviewed and considered on a continuing basis until a closing date of: **November 1, 2016**.
