

### Graduate Program Eligibility

1. A minimum average of B- (70%) in the applicant's last 10 technical courses, which translates to a 7 out of 12 on the McMaster GPA scale. The exception to this requirement is the MEME program, which requires an overall B average (8 out of 12 on the McMaster GPA Scale.)
2. A baccalaureate degree in the STEM fields (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics)
  - a. Non-STEM graduates with an interest in technology may be eligible for the MTEI program.
3. Work experience is desirable, but not essential.
4. Each applicant will be interviewed as part of the admission process.

**Note:** The W Booth School **DOES NOT** pre-screen applicants. All application documents must be uploaded and submitted via [MOSAIC](#) and the application fee processed before review.

### Application Process

1. A 1-2 page statement of interest in pursuing graduate studies. There is no required format for this document.
2. CV/Resume that outlines the applicant's academic and professional experience.
3. Two confidential letters of recommendation from instructors who are familiar with the applicant's academic work. **NOTE:** McMaster University uses an electronic referencing system. By entering the email address of a referee, the system will automatically send an e-reference request on the applicant's behalf, requesting the referee to submit their recommendation letter directly to McMaster. Personal email accounts are not acceptable. (Applicants do not have access to reference letters.)
4. Transcript of academic work in a sealed envelope from the university, along with the grading scale used at the university. If the transcript does not show that a degree has been conferred, an official university document stating that the degree has been conferred is also required. (Official transcript required upon applicant's acceptance of an offer of admission. Documents must prove the degree was conferred.)
5. If English is not the applicant's native language, we require an official copy of TOEFL **or** IELTS test results, or other evidence of competency in English. The IELTS score requirement is an overall band score of 6.5, with a minimum of 5.5 in each category, while the TOEFL score requirement is an overall score of at least 80.
  - a. If the language of instruction was English at the applicant's undergraduate Institution, TOEFL or IELTS tests are not required. If the language of instruction is not stated on the transcript, a letter from the applicant's undergraduate institution will suffice.
6. **FOR THE MEME PROGRAM ONLY:** a letter of support from a company that will sponsor the applicant's manufacturing project. This program requires students to find and carry out a project related to a manufacturing topic at an existing company. The company must be specified by the applicant prior to acceptance into the program. The letter should be on company letterhead and should include a brief description of the company, and the specified project the applicant will be working on at the company. The project involves the trouble shooting, improvement, and optimization of an existing process – not the designing of a new one. **\*\*\*An application CANNOT be reviewed without the letter of support for the MEME program. This document MUST be uploaded with the other application requirements for an application to be reviewed. \*\*\***

A GRE score is **NOT** required for admission into the programs offered by the W Booth School of Engineering Practice.

**PLEASE:** Do **NOT** provide any other documents other than the ones outlined above (i.e. certifications, GRE, high school transcripts, employer offer letters, etc. are **NOT** considered.)

**If an applicant is recommended by the review committee, he or she will receive an admission offer by mail in approximately one month.**
